<b>Passport/ ID document</b>	All foreigners who wish to pass the French customs must have a valid passport or ID document. For EU citizens, an ID card is sufficient. Passports and ID documents must be valid for the duration of your stay.
<b>Visa and resident permit</b>	<p>Students from outside EU need a long stay Student Visa when staying for over 3 months in France. The student Visa must be obtained before arriving in France. Students must contact the closest Consulate General of France.</p> <p>EU Citizens and those from countries within the Schengen area do not need a visa or a resident permit. However, citizens from outside Schengen Area wanting to find a job while studying must have a residence permit.</p>

<b>Civil Liability and Repatriation insurance</b>	<p>In order to enroll in a French University, students must provide civil liability insurance.</p> <p>It is strongly recommended to have repatriation insurance.</p>
