

Handling of Abandoned Bicycles and Vehicles

In order to preserve a favorable campus environment, the handling of abandoned vehicles (automobiles, light motor vehicles, motorcycles, motorized bicycles, and bicycles prescribed in the Road Traffic Act), based on the Guidelines for Prevention of Abandoned Vehicles etc. on the Campus of the University of Tsukuba, is as follows and users etc. are asked to take action immediately including their removal etc.

Note

Bicycles

- ① Bicycles that are damaged and impossible to ride will be considered abandoned.
- ② Bicycles that have been deemed unused will be considered abandoned.
- ③ Bicycles left around bus stops or car parking areas other than at bicycle-parking areas and bicycle-parking spaces will be considered abandoned.

A notice of removal will be attached to bicycles in question by June 30 (Fri.). The owners are asked to remove the notice off from their bicycles within 20 days after the date of the notice and to move their bicycles if parked in other than bicycle-parking areas and bicycle-parking spaces.

Vehicles (automobiles, light motor vehicles, motorcycles, motorized bicycles)

- ① Vehicles without number plates will be considered abandoned.
- ② Vehicles without valid car inspection parked at the same place for more than one consecutive month will be considered abandoned.
- ③ Vehicles that are damaged and impossible to drive, and have been left unattended for over a month will be considered abandoned.

A notice of removal will be attached to vehicles in question by June 30 (Fri.). The owners are asked to remove their vehicles within one month after the date of the notice.

※It is a crime to use abandoned bicycles by people other than their owners. University of Tsukuba strictly forbid to use or take bicycles stored for disposal on campus without prior permission.
