2. Selection Result / Notification

Please note that we will inform you of the room information by " Move-in (procedure) documents " around mid-March or end of March. (*Depending on the application, if you are not selected for all the rooms you like, any documents will not be sent to you.) If you do not have an address in Japan, we will inform you of the results by e-mail.

3. Period of Residence

Those who receive the Move-In [Procedure] document may live in the residence hall for the entire academic year, from the move-in date until March 31, 2025 (in the case of Global Village, the residency period is 2 years; until March 31, 2026).

Students are required to apply for student residence every year. Application notices will be posted around October on the bulletin boards in each residence hall office, and on TWINS

4.Moving-In

- 1) The move-in date will be set 1 or 2 days before the entrance ceremony. (*Please check the date on Moving-in [Procedure] Document).
- 2) The move-in date is written in the Move-in [Procedure] document, please complete your procedures and move into the room within the move-in date.

<Note1> All rooms require a deposit (30,000yen) as a move-in cost.

<Note2> All rooms have wireless (Wi-Fi) internet access.

<Note3> Depending on the application, the room type you are given may be not your first choice of room type.

5. Others

- 1) If you seek to have special consideration for your application due to disability-related circumstances, please send a certification (*It must be translated in English or Japanese) via email at qakuseisyukusya@un.tsukuba.ac.ip
- 2) Those who have fallen victims to natural disasters may also receive special consideration for their application. If you want to apply for a Residence Hall room, please send your request letter (*free format) and some certificates (ex. Disaster-Victim Certificate) via email at gakuseisyukusya@un.tsukuba.ac.ip
- 3) If applications exceed the number of available seats, the residents will be enrolled from out of the areas will be given priority in selection. Except when applicants need special consideration (disability-related circumstances, victims to natural disasters).
