## Application

### ● Application Procedure

Study Abroad students need to apply online and submit required documents by the application deadline.



### ● Upload the Documents

- Application Form
- Complete academic transcripts
- Recommendation letter from an instructor
- Certificate of Enrollment (at your home university)
- Information page from your passport
- Proof of language proficiency (exemption: English native speaker)

### ● Application Fee

- If you are applying from outside Taiwan, please pay an application fee of USD\$65 (non-refundable).
- Upload a scanned copy of your payment receipt to the system by the application deadline.

### ● Important Dates

Semester	Application Deadline
Fall September - December	May 31 <sup>st</sup>
Spring February - June	October 31 <sup>st</sup>

## Eligibility

- Have a minimum GPA (grade point average) of 2.5 on a 4-point scale, or equivalent.
- You should be a full-time student at your home institution during the application and study period.
- Have completed at least one year of full-time study at your home university.
- Please refer to program's individual **Language Requirements**.



### ► Buddy Program

The buddy program offers comprehensive assistance to international students, with current students acting as companions, providing peer support beyond administrative assistance and helping them adapt to life in Taiwan.



### ► Free Mandarin Courses

- FJCU's Center of Chinese Language and Culture offers small-sized classes with a teacher-student ratio of 1:7 to foster close interaction and maintain teaching efficiency.
- Our high-quality faculty is capable of teaching both Hanyu Pinyin and Zhuyin (Bopomopho) to meet the individual needs of international students and enhance all aspects of Mandarin proficiency.
- FJCU offers various student support programs. There are free weekly evening Mandarin courses totaling 6 hours, as well as a one-on-one tutoring program aimed at improving language proficiency.

### Accept your Offer

#### ► Apply for your Visa

Once your admission is approved, you can apply for a student visa using the Acceptance Letter.

#### ► Health Cover

- Please submit the Health Certificate for Residence Application issued by MOHW (Taiwan) for your medical examination.
- Before arriving Taiwan, you must purchase sufficient coverage of the international accident and medical insurance from your country to cover your entire stay in Taiwan.



#### ► Accommodation

- You may apply for on-campus dormitory accommodation or choose to live off-campus when submitting the application form. Please refer to the FJCU Housing Website for further information.
- Living on campus makes it easy to make friends with fellow students. You'll save both money and time on transportation. Additionally, walking to classes allows you to experience the natural environment of our campus, adorned with diverse trees.

FJCU also organizes club activities to allow students to experience local Taiwanese culture. These activities include tea tasting, exploring Hakka and Aboriginal culture, participating in special holiday projects, and enjoying Taiwanese cuisine.
