INFORMATION TO APPLY

• Documents required to the online form

1. **Grades Certificate** (English or Spanish). The average must be equal or superior to 5.0 in the Chilean scale of grades. <https://uchile.cl/u67619>
2. **Spanish Certificate** (DELE B1) or Level B1 certificate given by the home University. This requirement it is not mandatory for Spanish speakers. B2 in the case of students at the Faculty of Medicine.
3. **Passport copy** (identification sheet)
4. **Preliminary Learning agreement Form** with the subjects of interest.
5. Signing of the **Letter of Awareness of Harassment Policies** at Universidad de Chile
6. Updated COVID and influenza **vaccinations** (if you wish to enrol in the Faculty of Medicine)

• Academic Offer

It is recommended to go over the catalogue of previous semesters, due to most of the subjects are repeated year after year. To do so, visit the UCampus page of Universidad de Chile.

• Restrictions

Courses in areas such as Medicine and Odontology have restrictions when it comes to accepting exchange students. Students must present proof of three doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine, COVID-19 and Influenza vaccination, and provide recent boosters before arrival in Chile (COVID within the last 12 months and Influenza within the last 6 months).

Our Faculty of Economics only admits students whose academic background is directly related to the fields of economics, finance, or business, in order to ensure coherence with the programs offered.

Postgraduate applicants are analyzed case by case and only if the agreement explicitly mentions postgraduate mobility.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

• Academic Load

Exchange students are allowed to enroll in 5 courses maximum. This is 12 to 20 hours per week as a full academic load for one semester.

• Transcript of Records

The transcripts for the first semester are sent in August, and those for the second semester in January. Each student can access them by logging into their UCampus platform.

• Credits System

• Accommodations

The University of Chile does not provide guaranteed student housing. However, each semester the PME sends a form to apply for residences managed by the Direction of International Relations
