What is Trilateral Youth Summit?

Trilateral Youth Summit is a student exchange program started under the initiative of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Korea in 2014 and has been held annually since with the aim to deepen mutual understanding and foster friendships among students from China, Japan and the Republic of Korea. Held on a rotational basis, this year's program will take place in the Republic of Korea.

Through a week long intensive program, participants will discuss four agendas where the role of the youth is critical in the future (People-to-People and Local Exchange Committee, Sustainable Development and Disaster Relief Committee, Economy and Technology Committee, and Health and Aging Committee) and conduct mock Trilateral Summit on the last day. Various site visits and cultural experience opportunities will also be offered.

Eligibility

1. Citizens of the People's Republic of China, Japan, or the Republic of Korea, with priority given to applicants currently residing in their home country
2. Must be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program as of August 1, 2026.
3. Proficiency in English, knowledge of other CJK languages beyond one's native language is preferred but not required.
4. Basic understanding of and strong interest in Trilateral Cooperation
